

CARPENTER ASSISTANT JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION SUMMARY:

Assistant Carpenters are responsible for maintaining the wood structures in the Guest and Crew areas. Assisting with refurbishment and new installation in crew areas and Responding to work orders and repair requests the helping to maintain the ship so our guests can enjoy their vacation. Assistant Carpenters work alongside the Team Leader and Facilities Maintenance Manager and are a vital part of the Technical team who work hard behind the scenes to keep everything working and looking pristine.

This position description in no way states or implies that these are the only duties to be performed by the shipboard employee occupying this position. Employees may be required to perform any other job-related duties assigned by their supervisor or management. All duties and responsibilities are to be performed in accordance with the Company's Safety, Quality and Environmental standards.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assisting the Maintenance Team Leader in the routine maintenance and refurbishing work.
- Assisting the Staff Captain Facility Maintenance Manager as required.
- Being able to undertake jobs to provide help to the Masons, Joiners and Upholsters.
- Overseeing the fresh water bunkering.
- Attend all Safety drills and training as required.
- Any other reasonable task assigned by the FMM or Staff Chief Engineer. Ensuring that all aspects of the company's environmental policies and procedures are applicable to his/her job tasks, and are properly carried out to include but not limited to, the proper labelling of all hazardous material containers, as well as including those in which may be temporarily used, utilizing the proper storage and containment of hazardous chemicals including paints, the proper precautionary















procedures specified by the company when painting on-board or "over the side", and the proper application of the company's personnel protection program.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum 2-year experience as Carpenter, Experience of woodwork.
- Technical training in Carpentry.
- Completion of high school or basic education equivalency preferred.
- STCW certificate.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS:

- Excellent ability to speak English clearly, distinctly and cordially.
- Excellent ability to understand, read and write English in order to interpret written procedures, policies and manuals. This includes the ability to give and receive instructions in written and verbal forms and to effectively present information and respond to questions from guests, supervisors and co-workers.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- While performing the duties of this job, the shipboard employee is regularly required to stand; walk; use hands to touch, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; talk or hear; and taste or smell. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
- Extensive travel from ship to ship with varying accommodations and resting opportunities require good health. Active management of health through diet and exercise is a key for prolonged success in the position.
- All shipboard employees must be physically able to participate in emergency lifesaving procedures and drills. Full use and range of arms and legs as well as full visual, verbal and hearing abilities are required to receive and give instructions in















the event of an emergency including the lowering of lifeboats. The employee must have the ability to lift and/or move up to 55 pounds.

LEADS WITH PASSION, DRIVE AND ENERGY

- Promotes team unity at all levels within the Team and collaborates well with shipboard and shore side management.
- Shows motivation to learn and grow in the department.

ACTS WITH INTEGRITY

- Creates a climate of trust, mutual respect, and a professional image according to company standards. Be groomed meticulously and ready for guest service.
- Maintains guests' and employee confidence and protects the organization' s reputation by keeping guest and company information confidential. Enhances department and company reputation by accepting ownership and accomplishing a diversity of requests while exploring opportunities to add value to job accomplishments.
